Targa Texasland

We put on a regional targa event a few years ago, and as a competitor I can say that when a targa comes to town, you want to be part of it. This upcoming targa will be a national event that takes place entirely in Texas and will test your team's autocross, road rally, and time trials/time attack skills over the course of multiple days. At the end, your score will represent your performance across all three disciplines.

Targa Texasland will take place April 30th - May 5th, starting at MSR Cresson, move on to Harris Hill Raceway, MSR Houston, and finish up at Eagles Canyon Raceway. Just like all of our time trials events, if your car can make it through tech at an autocross or rallycross, it will pass tech at the targa. Solo

We've just had our 2nd autocross of the season, and I'd like to acknowledge our course designers. These have been really fun, challenging courses, and I look forward to our next event on April 27th at Burleson High School. Also, thank you Mother Nature — the weather was gorgeous at both events. There are a few classes that are starting to look particularly competitive early on: in C Street, D Street, E Street, and X Pro, the gap between 1st and 4th place has been less than one second at both events.

At event #1, Brandon Dan had the lowest raw time, Taylor Burnidge had the lowest PAX time, and the Novice PAX class was won by Matthew Keogh.

At event #2, top time of day was again put down by Brandon Dan, Brad McCann took top PAX, and Matthew Keogh won his 2nd event. A full list of results can be found on the [Solo Results Page](#).

The weekend of March 14th - 16th there was a national Pro-Solo hosted in Beeville Texas, and Texas Region was well represented with 12 trophy winners.

David Whitener won overall and Gerry Terranova was 3rd on the podium in E Street Touring. In Street 1, Joel Hall brought home a 6th place trophy. Brandon Slater and Ivy Chang both took home 2nd place trophies in Street 5 and Ladies Class 2. Kim Whitener won the top spot in Ladies Class 3. In the CAM class, Chris Cargill was our winner, while Mark Madarash and Wayne Atkins place 3rd and 5th. Congratulations to all of you!
