Road Race-

Coming off a 3 month summer break, there are two races left on the calendar for this year. The Sunburn Grand Prix takes place this weekend at Eagles Canyon raceway, and the Chili Pepper Double Regional will be December 12-14 at MSR Houston. If you haven't been a spectator at an SCCA Road Racing event, I highly recommend it. You'll see some of the closest wheel to wheel racing there is, and it's free!

Time Trials-

After 7 of our 10 time trials events, it's apparent that there will be quite a few classes where the season trophy's won't be decided until our final 3 track days. Those events will be on:

- October 25th at Motorsports Ranch Cresson - 3.1 CCW
- November 15th at Motorsports Ranch Cresson - 1.3 CCW
- December 6th Eagles Canyon Raceway - 1.65 CCW

Be sure to [register](#) early for these!

Here is a list of the classes that have yet to be decided:

- Max 1 - 14 points separate 1st place and 3rd place
- Max 4 - 2 way tie for 2nd place, both 16 points behind the leader
- Sport 2 - 2nd and 3rd are 10 and 18 points behind the leader respectively
- Sport 3 - 2 way tie for the top spot
- Sport 4 - 1st and 2nd are separated by only 2 points
- Sport 6 - 1st and 2nd are separated 5 points
- Tuner 2 - 2nd and 3rd are all within 9 points of the leader
- Tuner 4 - 2nd and 3rd are 7 and 9 points from 1st
- Tuner 5 - 1st and 2nd are also 9 points apart
- Unlimited 1 - 1st through 5th are only separated by 14 points
- Unlimited 2 - 1st and 2nd are 13 points apart

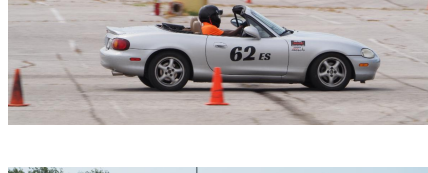
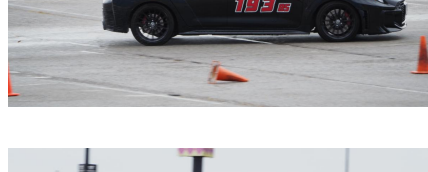
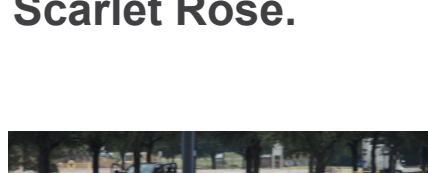
Road Rally

Registration has opened for the US Road Rally Challenge which will be held in Ohio. It's a 3 day event, which features time/speed/distance (TSD) stages on mostly unpaved roads, the weekend of October 10th - 12th. This year it will start in Canton Ohio, travel through some Ohio's most beautiful, twisty roads, and finish up Sunday in Cleveland.
