

Worker Guide - Sound

- ❖ **Course awareness and safety are critical** since you'll be working on an active course with cars driving at high speed
- ❖ You'll be working the course for 1-2 hours, so be prepared with sunscreen, a hat, and plenty of water
- ❖ On the sound meter, press the RESET button just before each car approaches, to clear the previous reading (there is no harm in pressing RESET multiple times between cars)
- ❖ Record car class, car number, and sound Db reading in the log for each car and run
- ❖ If a car exceeds 100 Db, call Race Control on the radio to report the car class, car number, and Db reading, so it can be relayed to the Sound Chief
- ❖ When the heat ends, leave the white copy in the clipboard and return the yellow copy to the trailer, so it can be posted
- ❖ If **not** the last heat, leave the clipboard and radio for the next sound worker
- ❖ If the last heat, return the clipboard, radio, and sound meter to the trailer
- ❖ We do not capture sound readings during significant rain, so if heavy rain starts while you're on course, turn off the sound meter and put it in a dry place, or cover it with a plastic bag if one is available
